**Unacceptable**: Scrap metal

**Preparation to Recycle**: Rinse and remove caps and lids.

## Aluminum

Acceptable: Aluminum cans

**Unacceptable**: Aluminum foil, pie plates, screws on lids, scrap metal and paint cans.

**Preparation to Recycle**: Empty all cans and rinse.

### **Newspaper**

Acceptable: Newspaper/office paper, pastel paper, white ledger paper, phone books, magazines, junk mail.

**Unacceptable**: Text books

**Preparation to Recycle**: Bag or box properly.

## **Used** Clothing

Acceptable: All 100% cotton clothing

**Preparation to Recycle**: Bag or box properly. Sorry, no shoes, belts or purses

# <u>Plastic</u>

Acceptable: Narrow neck bottles with the #1 or #2 on the bottle.

**Unacceptable**: Plastic tubs, toys, hard plastics, plastic bags, oil containers, pipe, margarine tubs or ice cream pails.

**Preparation to Recycle**: Rinse and remove caps and lids.

## **Cardboard**

Acceptable: Paper bags and corrugated boxes.

**Unacceptable**: Plastic Styrofoam, plastic coated boxes, cereal boxes, facial tissue boxes, paper board.

**Preparation to Recycle**: Empty and flatten all boxes, bundle, bag or box.

## All Occasion Cards

Acceptable: Any type of holiday, birthday or special occasion cards.

**Preparation to Recycle**: Bag or box properly so they don't become wet.
